The Commonwealth Union is an organization of 52 member states that are mostly former territories of the British Empire. The Commonwealth dates back to the mid-20th Century with a decolonization of the British Empire. The Commonwealth Day is one of our themed days that involves activities that mixes Geography, History, Sports and Creativity. The activity is dedicated to educating students in how the Organization was formed, the values and what the commonwealth means today.

- Commonwealth games: A special part of the Organization is the “Commonwealth Games” which is held every four years like the Summer Olympics with some different sports such as lawn bowls, hockey and athletics. This will be one of the activities. The groups will be put through their paces at the qualifying stages where they will try out some of the sports.
- The *Ingoma* Zulu dance is one of the purest remnants of Zulu tradition. Traditional Zulu dancing is an important part of the Zulu culture. Native to South Africa, the Zulu tribe has many rituals that have been passed from generation to generation over time. Dancing is one of the most common types of community rituals, and it is incorporated into most Zulu ceremonies. Zulu dances are signs of happiness and they occur when any significant event takes place.
- Indian spices include a variety of spices grown across the Indian subcontinent (a sub-region of South Asia). With different climates in different parts of the country, India produces a variety of spices, many of which are native to the subcontinent, while others were imported from similar climates and have since been cultivated locally for centuries.
- The country challenge involves using flash cards to discover different countries within the commonwealth, its culture, food, flags and capital cities. The group will be challenged to mix and match until they find the correct corresponding country.
- The British monarchy has a huge history we will present a video discussing the history of the british empire and where the commonwealth actually came from and its purpose today, later asking some questions and giving them small challenges depending on the age of the students.
- The commonwealth quiz is designed to challenge the students on their knowledge of the specific countries within the commonwealth and general knowledge of what the commonwealth is. Apart of this activity we will look into the charter of the commonwealth and what it stands for.
